1. The meeting of the South Lebanon Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman Stephen Krause, with Vice Chairman Jonathan Beers, Supervisor Robert Griffiths, Township Manager Jamie Yiengst, Assistant Township Manager Reba Donley, Police Chief Ken Zimmerman, Public Works Director Ron Johnson, and five (5) visitors present.
2. Chairman Krause led the group in saluting the flag.
3. VISITORS:
 - A. Tony and Tanner Zimmerman, 25 Wilhelm Avenue, Jeffrey Chernich, 452 Olde Meadow Lane, Jim Sak, 16 Edward Avenue, and Justin Hinkle, 1328 E. Old Cumberland St. were present to observe the meeting.
4. MINUTES:
 - A. The Minutes of the meeting held on August 27, 2024 were read and approved on motion by Griffiths, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.
5. REPORTS:
 - A. The Police Monthly Activity and Total Calls Reports for the month of August were reviewed and accepted on motion by Griffiths, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.
 - B. The Police Work Schedule for the month of October was approved on motion by Griffiths, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.
 - C. The Public Works Report for the month of August was read and accepted on motion by Griffiths, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.
 - D. The Board was given copies of the General Fund Income Statements ending August 31, 2024.
6. COMMUNICATIONS:
 - A. The Board read a letter from the First Baptist Church of Lebanon requesting to hold a 5K Run on various Township streets on October 19, 2024, and asking for South Lebanon Township Fire Police assistance with the event. The requests were approved on motion by Griffiths, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.

 - A. Bids for the sale of Used Township Equipment, as shown on the attached page, were approved on motion by Griffiths, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.
8. NEW BUSINESS:
 - A. The Board approved the Police Pension Plan Minimum Municipal Obligation for 2025 Budgeting Purposes on motion by Griffiths, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.
 - B. The Board approved the Non-Uniform Defined-Benefit Pension Plan Minimum Municipal Obligation for 2025 Budgeting Purposes on motion by Griffiths, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.
 - C. The Board approved the Non-Uniform Defined Contribution Pension Plan Minimum Municipal Obligation for 2025 Budgeting Purposes on motion by Griffiths, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.

- D. The Board reviewed a Petition for Special Exception from Yisel Henriquez Gonzalez and Yoan Henriquez for 595 Zinns Mill Road, and appointed Attorney Andrew Race to represent the Zoning Hearing Board and the Township Solicitor to represent the Township, on motion by Griffiths, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.
 - E. Permission to advertise for a full-time Road Crew employee was granted on motion by Griffiths, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.
9. Bills amounting to \$330,111.64 were individually examined and approved for payment on motion by Griffiths, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.
