The meeting of the South Lebanon Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman Stephen Krause, with Vice Chairman Jonathan Beers, Supervisor Robert Griffiths, Township Manager Jamie Yiengst, Assistant Township Manager Reba Donley, Police Chief Ken Zimmerman, and five (5) visitors present.
2. Chairman Krause led the group in saluting the flag.
3. VISITORS:

4. MINUTES:
 - A. The Minutes of the meeting held on September 24, 2024 were read and approved on motion by Griffiths, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.
 - B. The Minutes of the Budget Meeting held on October 1, 2024 were read and approved on motion by Griffiths, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.
5. REPORTS:
 - A. The Police Monthly Activity and Total Calls Reports for the month of September were reviewed and accepted on motion by Griffiths, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.
 - B. The Police Work Schedule for the month of November was approved on motion by Griffiths, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.
 - C. The Public Works Report for the month of September was read and accepted on motion by Griffiths, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.
 - D. The Board was given copies of the General Fund Income Statements ending September 30, 2024.
6. COMMUNICATIONS:
 - A. The Board read a letter from resident Matthew Lightner, commending the actions of Patrolmen Moser and Marderness during a call to his house on September 14, 2024.
7. OLD BUSINESS: None
8. NEW BUSINESS:
 - A. The DHL letter of credit for improvements at 3000 State Drive was reduced from \$15,660,400.00 to \$76,500.00 on motion by Griffiths, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.
 - B. The Board approved and signed Amendment #1 to an employment contract with the South Lebanon Township Police Officers Association, which allows for different work schedules, on motion by Griffiths, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.
 - C. Resolution # 1481, authorizing an application for Community Development Block Grant Funding, was approved on motion by Griffiths, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.
 - D. Resolution # 1482, Township of South Lebanon Fair Housing Resolution, was approved on motion by Griffiths, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.

9. Bills amounting to \$190,688.22 were individually examined and approved for payment on motion by Griffiths, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.
