1. The meeting of the South Lebanon Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman Stephen Krause, with Vice Chairman Jonathan Beers, Supervisor Jeffrey Chernich, Township Manager Jamie Yiengst, Assistant Manager Douglas Bishop, Police Chief Ken Zimmerman, Public Works Director Ron Johnson, Fire Police Captain Justin Hinkle and four (4) visitors present.
2. Chairman Krause led the group in saluting the flag.
3. VISITORS:
 - A. Darren Heisey, Steckbeck Engineering & Surveying, Inc., presented the Annual MS4 Public Education.
 - B. Jim Sak, 16 Edward Avenue, Meghan Burress, 604 S 4th Street and Gary Verna Jr, 1100 State Drive, were present to observe the meeting.
4. MINUTES:
 - A. The Minutes of the meeting held on October 28, 2025 were read and approved on motion by Beers, seconded by Krause. Motion passed with Chernich abstaining.
5. REPORTS:
 - A. The Police Monthly Activity and Total Calls Reports for the month of October were reviewed and accepted on motion by Chernich, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.
 - B. The Police Work Schedule for the month of December was approved on motion by Chernich, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.
 - C. The Public Works Report for the month of October was read and accepted on motion by Chernich, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.
 - D. The Board was given copies of the General Fund Income Statements ending October 31, 2025.
6. COMMUNICATIONS:
 - A. The Board read a letter from Jeffrey Chernich resigning his position as alternate on the Zoning Hearing Board. On a motion by Beers, seconded by Krause, the Board accepted his resignation with Chernich abstaining.
7. OLD BUSINESS:
 - A. Bids for the Sale of Used Township Equipment, as shown on the attached page, were approved on motion by Chernich, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.
8. NEW BUSINESS:
 - A. The 2026 meeting schedules for the Board of Supervisors and the Planning Commission were approved on motion by Chernich, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.
 - B. The Board approved Professional Pest Managers School for Ron Johnson and Travis Haak on December 8, 2025 in Grantville on motion by Chernich, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.
 - C. Alyssa Martin, Samantha McCarrick, Brandon Eberly, Calvin Leonard, Jackson Weaver, Joshua Proctor, Kyler Martin and Edward Price (Fire Police) were all approved as new members of the South Lebanon Fire Department on motion by Chernich, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.

- D. The Board approved Change Order #2 to the Township Building Project with Dutchman Contracting, to include Additional Heavy-Duty Asphalt and a Gas Riser Relocation, on motion by Chernich, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.
9. Bills amounting to \$468,989.69 were individually examined and approved for payment on motion by Chernich, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.
10. The meeting was adjourned at 7:38 p.m. by Chairman Krause.
