



Can adults do these hikes?

Absolutely! We've had adults participating in the **Get Outdoors (GO)** program for years, but now there's a way to keep track of all your hikes, using an online app called **Beanstack**.

How Get Outdoors (GO) works

There are "site markers" – wooden posts with an etched plate attached – that are hidden in various locations in seven counties: **Adams (15 site markers), Cumberland (15), Franklin (15), Lancaster (20), Lebanon (15), Union (13), and York (31)**. There are **124 hikes** across the seven counties! After registering for the **Get Outdoors** program at a local library, participants follow clues in the guidebook (called a **Ledger** this year) to find these posts. The hikes are varying lengths and have various difficulty levels (indicated in the guidebook). When you find the site marker, you'll see the etching plate with a 4-digit code on it. You can enter this code online using the **Beanstack** app to receive credit for that hike.

How to register at libraries

You'll need to have a library card to register for the hikes, which you can obtain by visiting any of the following county library system websites:
