

## MINUTES

South Lebanon Township

May 26, 2026

1. The meeting of the South Lebanon Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman Stephen Krause, with Vice Chairman Jonathan Beers, Supervisor Jeffrey Chernich, Township Manager Jamie Yiengst, Assistant Township Manager Douglas Bishop, Township Solicitor Keith Kilgore, Fire Police Captain Justin Hinkle, one (1) visitor and one (1) news reporter present.
2. Chairman Krause led the group in saluting the flag.
3. VISITORS:
  - A. Jim Sak, 16 Edward Avenue, was present to observe the meeting, and ask questions regarding rates for public water and sewer.
4. MINUTES:
  - A. The Minutes of the meeting held on May 12, 2026, were read and approved on motion by Chernich, seconded Beers. Motion passed unanimously.
5. REPORTS:
  - A. The Fire Department Report for April was read and accepted on motion by Chernich, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.
  - B. The Fire Police Report for April was read and accepted on motion by Chernich, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously. Vice Chairman Beers requested that info on mutual aid given be included in future reports.
  - C. The Property Maintenance Code Report for the month of April was read and accepted on motion by Chernich, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.
  - D. The Board read and accepted a copy of the 2025 Annual Audit of Township Funds on motion by Chernich, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.
6. COMMUNICATIONS:
  - A. The Board read a letter from the Borough of Cornwall Council inquiring if South Lebanon Township would have interest in pursuing joint or multi-municipal zoning. On a motion by Chernich, seconded by Beers, the Board was not in favor of enacting a joint zoning ordinance, but would be willing to listen to a limited proposal to address a specific issue. Motion passed unanimously.
7. OLD BUSINESS:
  - A. The Board read a notice from First Aid & Safety Patrol as a follow up from previous correspondence regarding Schaefferstown EMS Quick Response Unit receiving notifications for ambulance calls in South Lebanon Township. First Aid & Safety Patrol, Schaefferstown EMS and Lebanon County Dept of Emergency Services are drafting a Memorandum of Understanding to address this issue.
8. NEW BUSINESS:
  - A. Resolution # 1554, application for funding from the Commonwealth Financing Authority for a Sewage Facilities Plan Update, was approved on motion by Chernich, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.

- B. Patrol Rifle Instructor training was approved for Corporal Juliani on October 13-15, 2026 in Hershey, PA on motion by Chernich, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.
9. Bills amounting to \$80,480.81 were individually examined and approved for payment on motion by Chernich, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.
10. The meeting was adjourned at 7:20 p.m. by Chairman Krause.
