

## MINUTES

South Lebanon Township

June 9, 2026

1. The meeting of the South Lebanon Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman Stephen Krause, with Vice Chairman Jonathan Beers, Supervisor Jeffrey Chernich, Township Manager Jamie Yiengst, Assistant Manager Douglas Bishop, Police Chief Ken Zimmerman, Fire Police Captain Justin Hinkle, one (1) visitor and one (1) news reporter present.
2. Chairman Krause led the group in saluting the flag.
3. VISITORS:
  - A. Jim Sak, 16 Edward Avenue, was present to observe the meeting.
4. MINUTES:
  - A. The Minutes of the meeting held on May 26, 2026, were read and approved on motion by Chernich, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.
5. REPORTS:
  - A. The Police Monthly Activity and Total Calls Reports for the month of May, were reviewed and accepted on motion by Chernich, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.
  - B. The Police Work Schedule for the month of July was approved on motion by Chernich, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.
  - C. The Public Works Report for the month of May was read and accepted on motion by Chernich, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.
  - D. The Board was given copies of the General Fund Income Statements ending May 31, 2026.
  - E. The District Justice Report for the month of May, indicating traffic fines of \$4,948.34 and non-traffic fines of \$245.09, for a total of \$5,193.43 collected, was accepted on motion by Chernich, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.
6. COMMUNICATIONS:
  - A. The Board read a letter from Cub Scout Pack # 412 requesting permission to hold a Recruiting Event at South Hills Park on June 29, 2026 from 6:30 pm to 8:30 pm to include games, crafts, and food trucks. Permission was granted, with the stipulation that two (2) parking attendants are provided, on motion by Chernich, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.
  - B. The Board read a letter from Eastern Lebanon County School District requesting permission to host the Annual Lancaster-Lebanon Cross Country Championships at South Hills Park on October 20, 2026. On motion by Chernich, seconded by Beers, the Board approved the event with the following stipulations. Motion passed unanimously.
    1. Additional portable toilets provided.
    2. Minimum of 4 parking attendants.
    3. May not charge admission, by donation only.
  - C. The Board read a letter from the Cedar Crest High School Class of 2027 requesting to host a food truck event at South Hills Park on September 10, 2026 from 4:00 pm to 8:00 pm. Permission was granted, with the stipulation that at least four (4) parking attendants are provided, on motion by Chernich, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.
  - D. The Board read a letter from the Tour de Lebanon Valley committee requesting to ride through South Hills Park and utilize Township roads as part of the course for the 8<sup>th</sup> Annual Event on June 13, 2026. Permission was granted on motion by Chernich, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.

7. OLD BUSINESS: None

8. NEW BUSINESS:

A. The letter of credit for Little Bees Pediatric Dentistry was reduced from \$83,500.00 to \$4,000.00 on motion by Chernich, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.

9. Bills amounting to \$724,096.96 were individually examined and approved for payment on motion by Chernich, seconded by Beers. Motion passed unanimously.

10. The meeting was adjourned at 7:12 p.m. by Chairman Krause.
